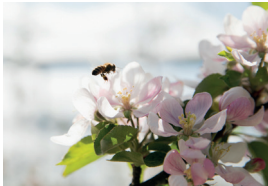

Casa Albinei

Casa Albinei stems from a family tradition that has developed from a small hobby into a thriving company. For more than 60 years, three generations have passed through their love for bees and beekeeping. Their expertise is nationally acknowledged as the company is a leader in beekeeping and the processing of honey in the Republic of Moldova. Next to producing 100% natural premium honey and other apiculture products, Casa Albinei is responsible for the processing, packaging, and marketing of their honey.

Casa Albinei maintains more than 500 bee families that produce together circa 20 tons of honey per year. Additionally, the company buys honey from beekeeping partners in other regions of the country. The honey collected from their own hives and the honey purchased from partners is being tested for antibiotic residues. The honey is homogenized in Casa Albinei's own production facility and further tested in European laboratories. This careful process ensures the highest quality natural products that meet the requirements of the European market.

Each year an average of 500 tons of honey is produced and processed for export. Most of this produce is exported to Italy, Russia, Cyprus, Estonia, and Japan. Casa Albinei offers packaging options ranging from glass jars and plastic containers to large barrels.

Tiferet



Tiferet is a grower as well as a producer of frozen fruits and berries that are used for further production of products such as juices, baby food, natural puree, smoothies, and jams.



Tiferet is concerned with the question how high-quality fruit can be shared with people all around the world that enjoy healthy food. The aim is therefore to keep on improving and innovating their produce of high-standard fruits and berries by using shock freezing techniques.



The factory in the Causeni region of Moldova was chosen due to a local abundance of fruits. The factory is only a few kilometers from the fields, which enables Tiferet to freeze fruits right after picking as to save the fruit's richness at most. By freezing it immediately after the fruits are harvested, all vitamins are preserved.

Tiferet mainly exports to the European Union, Canada, Ukraine, and Russia.

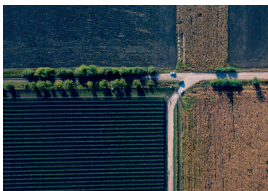
